If You're Over Age 60 It's Easier Than You Think!

- **Free application assistance** for seniors through FTAAD at **423-722-5093**
- **No trips to DHS office**—Interviews are done by phone

PLUS EXTRA BENEFITS:

- **Special deductions** and higher asset limits for 60+ applicants
 - ◆ **Asset limit** is \$4,250
 - ◆ **Out-of-pocket medical/health expenses** deduction (over \$35/month)
 - ◆ No maximum “**excessive shelter costs**” deduction limit
- SNAP EBT cards are **accepted at local farmers markets** and can be used to buy groceries online at **Amazon.com and Walmart.com**
- SNAP recipients may be eligible for AT&T's Access program, which offers broadband **internet service for only \$10** per month, and **free cell phones and service** through companies like SafeLink Wireless and Assurance Wireless
